- The UCI Artistic Cycling World Cup ranking is drawn up on the basis of the points won by each rider or team (pair, ACT4) in accordance with the tables as follows.
- The points awarded to the riders and teams (pair, ACT4) in the preliminaries are also valid for the final.
- Riders or teams (pairs, ACT4) who achieve place 1 to 10 in the UCI Artistic Cycling World Cup ranking after the three preliminaries are qualified for the final event in the respective discipline.

The leader's jersey may only be worn at UCI Artistic Cycling World Cup events, and in no other event. The colours of the leader's jerseys are determined by the UCI.
